On Sun. Oct. 10th the worst outrage in Toronto's history hit our city. At 9:10 p.m. a bomb exploded with terrific force at the Mountain Lake Lodge, while children's games were in progress. Several women and children were injured.



It took that terror in the Greater West end against women and children.

Our organization, the Association of United Ukrainian Canadians, has over 50 years of rich history behind it. The Children's Concert that was Bombed!

When the time-book went off at 8:15 p.m. a group of children had just left the stage. For over 20 years now women and children occupy the front rows of the auditorium because our children act in turn as audience and performers. This Thanksgiving Day Concert was in the nature of a review of the musical educational work presented by our children's groups for their parents.

The bomb, filled with rail spikes was set near the stage. That it was aimed towards the front of the hall can only mean that the conspirators planned mass murder of women and children.

We of the Ukrainian-Canadian community in Toronto have lived in this city most of us for a quarter of a century or more. Most of us were born here. We are Canadian. We have homes and families.

We have our different organizations and churches. We have our differences like any other community. But during the last 40 years since our people came out in large numbers to Toronto there has never been such an act of terrorism. None of the older groups would even think of attempting to murder 50 women and children. Nor is it

true of the majority of the D.P.'s who in spite of varying opinions would never condone murder of innocent children.

This outrage is not the result of a conflict between rival groups. Such a suggestion only covers the murderers of European people and the would-be murderers of Canadians. Our women and children at the Thanksgiving Day Concert who form the basis of our organization are not gangsters. They are in conflict with no group. They are decent, law-abiding, home-loving citizens who ask the protection of the law-enforcement agencies from the terrorists.

This outrage is but the latest in a series of acts of violence by the terrorists. In Edmonton, Winnipeg and Toronto they have made violent attacks on our public assemblies. Three of the men who organized the infamous Nazi SS Division the "Halachras", are now in Toronto or were here until recently. We have given their names to the police.

After leaving a trail of thousands of murders in many lands of Europe behind them they have come to Canada to continue their Nazi practices.

What we're up against is not an individual crime but organized, planned, persistent terror by a gang whose life has for two decades been centred on murder.
