

# The Ball-Room Call Book.

SRE think that such a book as this is needed. Books about dancing in general, and learned dissertations on the origin of particular kinds of dancing, are as numerous as leaves upon the ground in autumn. But a common-sense Call Book that will tell all that is needed, and then stop, has not hitherto been published. This book aims at enabling every reader to all if the various dances, popular in every grade of society. No one can possibly misunderstand the "calls" as printed in this book. They are all plain, pure, and simple. While this book will be valuable to the leader as a ready reference, where his memory may be at fault, to others it will be a teacher. that will fit them not only properly to figure on the floor, but to take the place of leader whenever they may desire to do so. While the leader of the orchestra, presumed to know all about the routine of dancing, is usually relied upon to give the necessary calls, it often happens that that individual is unable properly to fill the position. He may be a foreigner, unable to speak our language plainly, or he may not be thoroughly acquainted with the kind of dances popular in that particular place. Whoever undertakes to make the "calls," should enunciate every syllable plainly, for a word misunderstood may throw all the sets into con-There should be no loud bawling; but the words fusion. should be uttered in a tone of sufficient force to be heard in every corner of the hall

QUADRILLES—as the name implies—are danced by four couples. A couple occupying each side of the square. The gentleman is on the left side of his partner; a lady of course.

BALLS always are begun with a Grand March It is the duty of the floor managers to arrange thu company in proper lines for the march.
