To the Chairman and Members of the Committee on Fire and Light :

GENTLEMEN,—I have the honor to herewith submit the report of the Fire Department for the year ending December 31st, 1900.

The number of fires and alarms responded to by the Department during the year being 746, or 93 less than in 1899, but with that exception is the largest for any one year in the history of the City.

The total loss by fire for the year was \$182,334.26, with a total insurance of \$993,935.00. The aggregate losses on buildings were \$58,778.35; with an insurance of \$497,385.00 ; and aggregate losses on contents, \$123,555.91, with an insurance of \$496,550.00.

The amount of insurance paid was \$159,611.26 ; the losses over insurance paid were \$13,289.00 ; and the losses where there was no insurance amounted to \$9,434.00

Attached hereto will be found a complete list of the officers and men comprising the Department, with the relative positions and location of each ; the number of

horses, the different apparatus, the quantities of hose and all other properties owned by the Department, and where located.

In the Annual Report of 1899, I recommended the placing of a hook and ladder truck in Cowan Avenue Fire Station and also replacing the truck now in Ossington Avenue Fire Station by a more modern apparatus.

I trust the Committee of 1901 will see that a Station is erected on the lot owned by the City south of the Cowan Avenue Station, and that funds be placed in the estimates to purchase those apparatus so that the suggested improvements may be acquired, thereby greatly strengthening the efficiency of the Department.

In my report of last year I recommended that as soon as the necessary alterations to accomodate a steam fire engine were made at the Portland Street Fire Hall, one of the engines at present located at the Bay Street Fire Hall be placed there. The necessary changes have been completed and the "Boustead" Engine has been transferred to Portland Street Fire Hall, making room for the 65-foot Aerial Truck, now being constructed by the Waterous Engine Works Co. of Brantford, and which will in a few days be delivered.

I would also recommend the purchase of a lot and the erection of a Station thereon in the neighborhood of Wellington and York Streets for the purpose of relieving the overcrowded Bay Street Station, and also to contain hose and salvage wagons for the better protection of this very important part of the City.

I find that the water supply and pressure in that part of the City north of College Street is quite inadequate for fire extinguishing purposes, and it is very important that

this matter should be attended to as early as possible. I also consider it absolutely necessary to have the 4-inch water mains largely prevailing at present in No. 6 Ward replaced by larger mains, so that this rapidly growing part of the City can be assured of an efficient fire protection.

I also wish to call the attention of the Committee to the necessity of amending the building By-law, and the By-law governing the keeping and storing of benzine, oils and other explosives, and the vital importance of having the overhead wires in the centre of the City put under ground, as at present they are not only a hinderance to the Fire Department in discharging their duty, but have become a dangerous menace to both life and property.

I also take this opportunity of sincerely thanking the officers and men of the Police Department for the manner in which they have on all occasions possible kindly given every assistance in their power to this Department.

In conclusion, allow me to return my sincere thanks for the many courtesies extended to the officers and members of the Department by your Committee during the year.

John Thompson, Chief of Fire Department:

DEAR SIR,—I submit herewith a report of the extensions and repairs to the Fire Alarm Telegraph for the year ending December 31st, 1900.

During the year we have put up three new alarm boxes, and owing to the Telephone and Electric Light Companies rebuilding their lines we have had to remove a number of our boxes to new poles.

I have paid strict attention to the repairs of our alarm boxes, batteries and lines, which have worked perfectly during the year we having four hundred alarms pass through the repeater, all of which were perfectly transmitted.

I find it difficult in many localities to get people to take charge of keys for the alarm boxes and would suggest that in many places a key should be left in the alarm box the same as in door of box I furnish herewith.

Trusting that the Committee on Fire and Light for the year 1901, will place a sufficient amount in the estimates to enable me to make the following repairs :

A standard 14 inch gong for Yonge St. Engine House and Kew Beach Fire Hall; the placing of a small test-switch in each of the Fire Halls so that I may the more readily locate trouble on our circuits, the switches would cost about \$2.00 each.

I consider it necessary to thoroughly repair parts of 1, 2, 4 and 6 circuits, which at present have a quantity of old and bad wire that should be replaced by new, and in some places insulated wire. There are also a number of alarm boxes the works of which should be thoroughly cleaned and

laquered and the outside cases painted. It would also be advisable to have all box poles painted a conspicuous color so the public would know where our boxes are located.

The following is a correct inventory of the property in my charge:

- 1 10-circuit repeater.
- 1 " switch-board.
- 11 galvanometers.
- 5 bell strikers.
- 345 cells of battery.
- About 95 miles of wire, poles, etc.
- 191 fire alarm boxes.
- 21 fire alarm gongs.
