*To the Chairman and Members of the Committee on Fire
and Light:*

GENTLEMEN,—In compliance with the rules governing the Fire Department, I have the honor to herewith submit the annual report of the Department, for the year ending December 31st, 1903.

During the year the Department responded to 867 alarms; this in number exceeds anything previous in the history of the Department, being 69 in excess of 1902 and 212 in excess of 1901. A few of those alarms were false, given by breaking the glass covering the locks on our street boxes, but the trouble from this source was not nearly so great during the past year as that of the year previous, showing that the action of the Committee in offering a reward for the conviction of offenders in this direction, is having the desired effect, or that the citizens are educating their boys to abstain from this senseless and dangerous practice.

Notwithstanding the very large number of fires, the loss for the year has been kept down well below the average, the total loss being \$273,696.70 as compared with \$423,544 in the year previous. \$37,638 of this loss occurred at the

Ferry Company's property on the Island and is not properly chargeable to our losses, as they furnished their own fire protection and was insured on those conditions.

The other fires entailing heavy losses were, the Toronto Opera House, the steamboat "White Star," the Consumers' Gas Company's coal and coke sheds, and John Inglis and Company's office and storehouse on Strachan Avenue.

It is gratifying to be able to state that not one of the large fires during the year spread beyond the building in which it started.

ACCIDENTS.

The accidents to the members of the Department were frequent during the year, but I am happy to say, not one was of a fatal and very few of a serious or dangerous character.

APPARATUS.

In the early part of the year, the new hook and ladder truck ordered last year for Ossington Avenue was placed in commission in that station; a new truck built by Seagrave, of Walkerville, Ont., and equipped with Seagrave trussed ladders, was purchased and placed in commission in Portland Street station; the 85-ft. Aerial truck from Lombard Street station is now at Walkerville, being changed to the latest and most improved easy and quick hoisting ladder of that description, and will be ready for service in a

few weeks, and the large "Waterous" engine at Bay Street station was sent to Brantford and had the engine motion entirely changed, the boiler equipped with copper tubes and the whole apparatus painted, striped and varnished, and is now a first-class steam fire engine. Those improvements are undoubtedly an added strength to the fire fighting equipment of the Department, and were absolutely necessary to keep pace with the growing needs of the City.

HOUSES OR STATIONS.

A great many of our stations are in anything but a satisfactory condition; a beginning has been made during the year to make repairs of a thorough and permanent character, notably at Yonge Street station, upper Dundas Street station, and the appropriation of sufficient money to build a new station at Berkeley Street. I trust this system will go on until all the houses are placed in a sanitary and comfortable condition.

During the coming year Lombard Street station should be completely overhauled, sitting rooms for the men built at the Portland station and at Rose Avenue station, a station erected to contain a hook and ladder truck at Cowan Avenue, and a lot secured and building erected thereon, to contain a hose wagon with full equipment for the protection of the property in that part of the City east of the Woodbine, and a lot should certainly be secured in the centre of the City on which to erect a proper central fire station, to take the place of the present Bay Street station, which has not and cannot be changed to give the necessary accommodation required for that part of the City.

HORSES.

The horses in the Department are from year to year being kept up to a proper standard and in good condition. During the year eleven new horses were purchased and

eight considered unfit for service were disposed of. This leaves a total of sixty-eight in the Department.

WATER MAINS.

On a number of occasions during the year, the Department found the water supply for fire purposes anything but satisfactory, notably at the fire in the Gas Company's coal and coke sheds on Parliament Street and at the John Inglis & Company's fire on Strachan Avenue.

I would therefore recommend that the 24-inch main running east on Front Street to Church Street, be continued east to and connected with the 12-inch main on Sumach Street, and that the 6-inch main running south from King Street on Strachan Avenue be replaced by a 12-inch main and carried through to connect with the 12-inch main running through the Exhibition grounds from Dufferin Street, that the 6-inch main running east from the foot of Bathurst Street be continued east and connected with the 6-inch main at the south end of Spadina Avenue.

I also consider that the rapid increase of the buildings in the northern part of the City, makes it necessary to increase the power of the pumping plant at the High Level station and also enlarging a number of the mains on that system.

I would also again call the attention of the Committee to the fact that there is still in No. 6 Ward a number of old 4-inch water mains that should be replaced by larger mains as soon as possible.

OVERHEAD ELECTRIC WIRES.

I must again call the attention of the Committee and Council to the serious danger to both life and property existing in the overhead electric wires in the centre of the City, and would earnestly request that some steps be taken to place them underground before valuable property be destroyed and perhaps human life sacrificed.

It affords me great pleasure to testify to the loyal support and able assistance I have received from every officer in the Department, and to the satisfactory and efficient manner in which both officers and men have performed their various and often dangerous duties during the year.

I have again to thank the officers and men of the Police Force for the able assistance rendered our Department on all occasions possible; also the press and public in general for the many compliments received for the efficient work done by the Department during the year.

In conclusion I return my sincere thanks to the Chairman and Members of the Committee on Fire and Light, for the courteous treatment I have received at their hands, and for the interest they have taken in the welfare of the Department during the year.

FOR THE YEAR 1903.

TORONTO, December 31st, 1903.

Mr. John Thompson, Chief of Fire Department :

DEAR SIR,—Following the usual custom, I present a statement of the working of the Fire Alarm System for the past year, during which time strict attention has been given to the testing of alarm boxes and repairs to line wires, both being kept in good repair. Four hundred and eight-eight alarms passed through the repeater and all were perfectly transmitted to the various Fire Stations.

During the year four new alarm boxes were added to the system and a number of others have been moved and placed on new poles.

On April 29th the three small hose houses at the Island were connected with the Island pumping station by electric bells, and kept in operation until November 1st. Owing to the many new buildings on the Exhibition grounds, we found it necessary to rebuild the circuit, connecting the seven local alarm boxes with the Fire Station on the grounds, and this was kept in operation during the exhibition.

Although the system is at present satisfactory, we should, in my opinion, have a fifteen or twenty-circuit central office system to be in a position for properly meeting the demands likely to be made in the near future.

The following is a correct inventory of the property in my charge :

- 1 10-circuit repeater.
- 1 10 " switchboard.
- 11 galvanometers.
- 5 large bell strikers.
- 400 cells of gravity battery.
- 97 miles of wire, poles, etc.
- 196 fire alarm boxes.
- 28 gongs.
