# Facts About Toronto

**The City of Toronto** is situated upon the northern shore of Lake Ontario, on a plain gently ascending north for a distance of three miles, where an altitude of about 120 feet above the lake level is reached. It extends about eight miles along the lake, and is generally level. The River Don flows through the eastern part of the City, and the River Humber is immediately to the west of its western limit. THE CLIMATE is not as extreme in winter as in some of the eastern Canadian cities, and in summer the heat is tempered by the gentle breeze which blow from off the cool waters of the lake. The area within the City Limits is 50,191 acres, or 14.2 square miles.

In 1910 there were a population of persons in City limits of 240,000.

There are 107 miles of streets, including avenues, alleys, boulevards and streets under construction.
