Bishop Strachan Jubilee Fund.

"The Lord Bishop of Quebec has communicated to the Society in a letter dated June 25, 1803, that the Mission of Cornwall has been filled up by a Mr. STRACHAN, whom the Bishop ordained for that purpose, having been first mentioned to the Bishop by GOVERNOR HUNTER, as desiring to obtain Holy Orders in the Church of England, and afterwards recommended by Mr. CARTWRIGHT, a member of the Executive and Legislative Councils, by Dr. STUART, by Mr. CHIEF JUSTICE ELSLEY, and by many other gentlemen worthy of great regard and respect; and the Bishop further adds, that upon examination he was so well satisfied with respect to Mr. STRACHAN's principles, attainments, conversation and demeanor, that he must confess that he shall be more than commonly disappointed if he do not become a very useful and respectable minister."

From the above extract it appears that the present year is the fiftieth Anniversary or Jubilee Ministerial year of our venerable and beloved Bishop, and it is proposed that in order to commemorate the interesting event, a BISHOP STRACHAN JUBILEE FUND shall be raised, the object of which shall be to obtain at least £10,000, out of which to complete the buildings of Trinity College, and the surplus (if any), after the completion of the buildings, to be appropriated by the General Committee, under the sanction of the Lord Bishop, to the foundation of Scholarships, or such other objects connected with Trinity College as to them may seem fitting.
