All other Taxes are due and payable 25th OCTOBER, 1880, subject to the following: The amount to be collected is to be given for payment on the principal payment of the first instalment on and 25th OCTOBER, 1880, but not otherwise, on extension of time to be given for payment of second instalment until 11th DECEMBER, 1880, subject to the proviso that the right of the collector in every case where he may consider it expedient, after a proper demand has been made, to proceed at any time before said several days, or either of these specified as aforesaid, with the collection of any taxes for interest and sale under the provisions of the Assessment Law thereto relating.

**COLLECTOR.—ANDREW SMILEY.**

**At Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Yorkville.**

**OFFICE HOURS.**—The Collector can be called on at the Clerk's Office, as above, which is open daily from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m., and on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 2.30 p.m., and from 9 a.m. until 8 p.m. for three days preceding the 26th OCTOBER and 11th DECEMBER, and to the hour of 10 o'clock p.m. on those days.

**PER CENTAGE.**—An addition of 5 per cent. shall be made to every tax rate or assessment remaining unpaid after the 25th OCTOBER; and also an addition of 5 per cent. to all AMOUNTS PAYABLE on the 11th DECEMBER, and remaining unpaid after that date.

And it shall be the duty of the Collector immediately after the said several days appointed for payment, to collect at once, by distress or otherwise, under the provisions of the Statute in that behalf made, all such taxes or instalments of taxes, rates, and assessments, as have not been paid on or before the said several days appointed for payment, together with the said percentage charge of 5 per cent. upon the amount of every such unpaid tax rate or assessment.

**ALLOWANCE FOR PAYMENT IN ADVANCE.**—Ratepayers who prefer to pay their total taxes on or before the 25th day of OCTOBER shall be entitled to a reduction of 2 per cent. on the amount of the second instalment.

**EARLY ATTENDANCE** is requested, as more convenient and comfortable to the ratepayers and all concerned.
