I took a walk



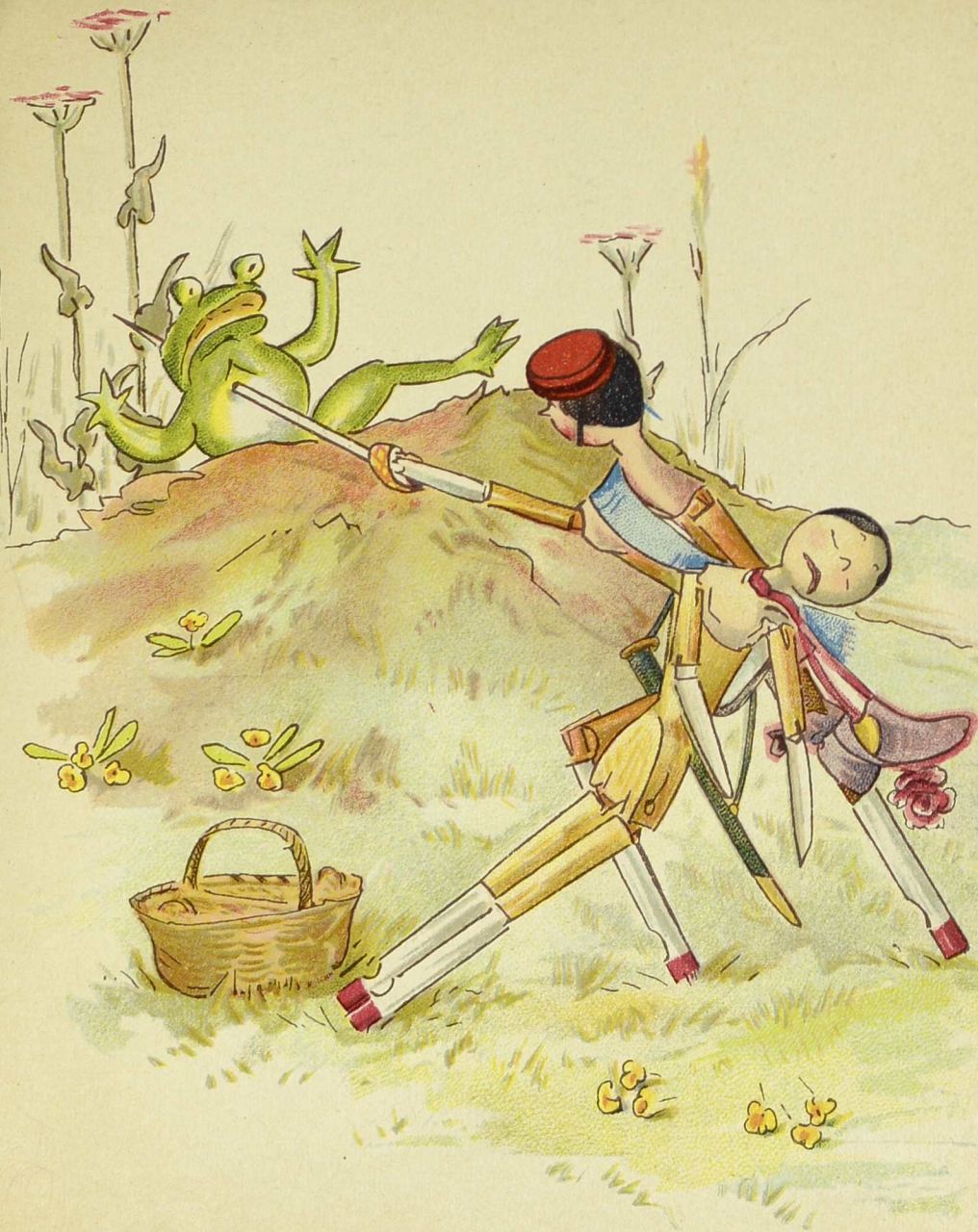
in a lovely wood.

came to see me off!

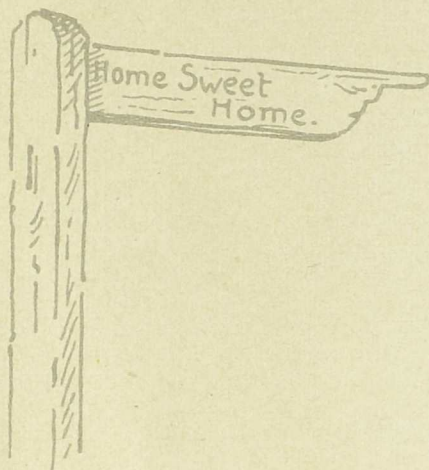

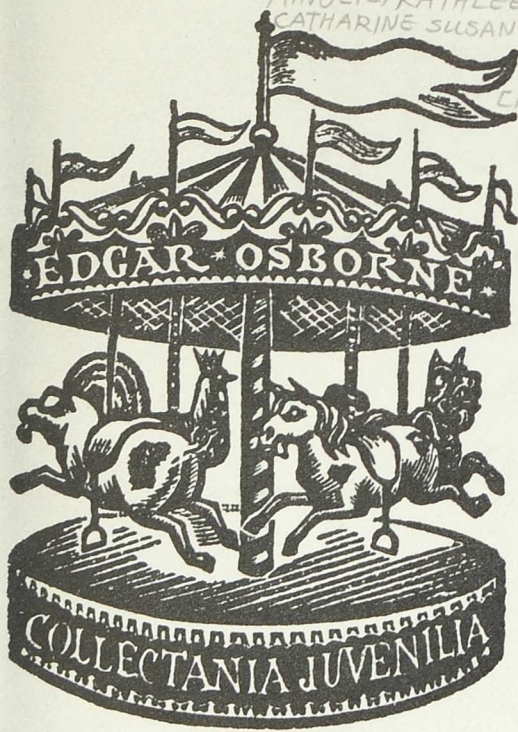
