



TEEN-AGERS in search of material for essays, debates and oral compositions kept the High School Room at the main library busy.



AN ALL-TIME HIGH in borrowing was set in 1958 with 394,109 books borrowed for home reading, an increase of 45,021 books over 1957, or 13 per cent.

BOYS AND GIRLS borrowed the greatest number of books in 1958. They took home 217,529 books in 55 per cent of all books borrowed, 22,153 more books than they borrowed in 1957. Staff members of the staff of the staf

LONG-PLAYING RECORDS were in big demand. The 372-record collection circulated 1382 times during 1958.

HISTORY AND PRACTICAL SCIENCE received the greatest attention from adults who borrowed 45 percent of all books taken out in 1958. Their 176,580 books borrowed exceeded 1957 by 22,868.
