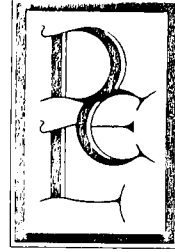

First Edition of the first atlas published in Canada. This rare school atlas is not listed in any of the relevant bibliographies nor have we been able to find any records of a copy being offered for sale. TPL cites an 1844 edition with ten maps and an advertisement for the first edition of the atlas on the back cover.

Armour and Ramsay's atlas contains maps of the eastern and western hemispheres, Europe, Asia, Africa, British Isles, South America, United States, North America and Canada. All of the maps include the name of the publisher, but not the cartographer or engraver; TPL notes the maps in the 1844 edition were drawn and engraved by J. Gellatly of Edinburgh.

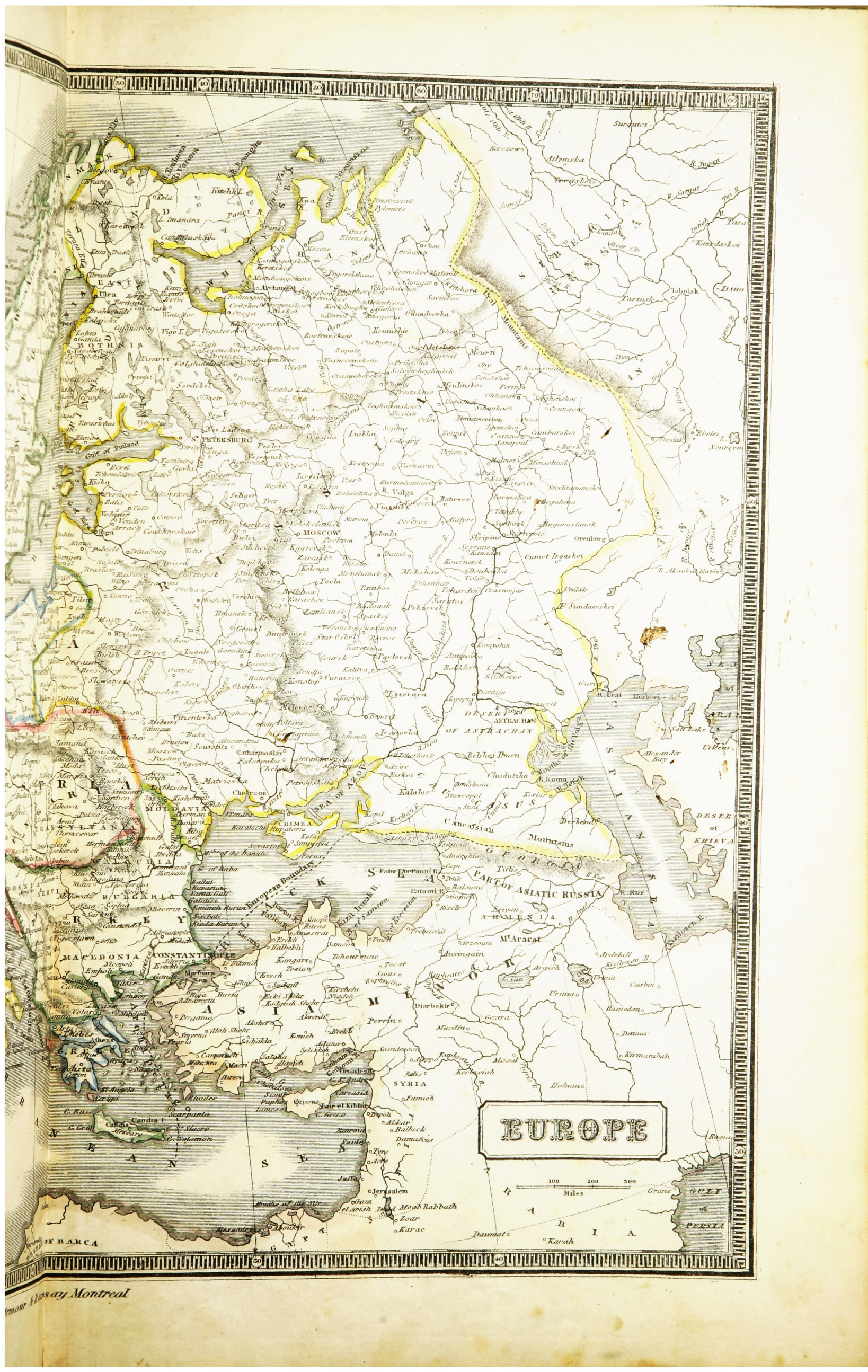

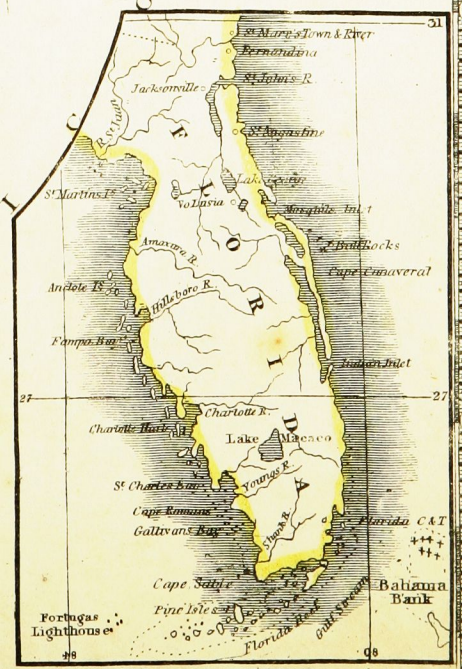
