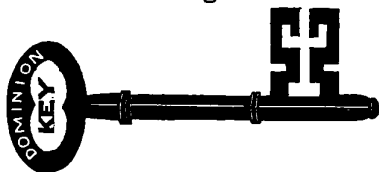

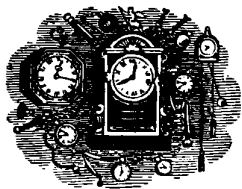

PROGRESS OF LONDON.

STATISTICS OF THE ASSESSMENT OF 1870—INCREASE OF POPULATION.

The assessors of the city having duly completed their rolls for the year 1870, returned them to the City Clerk. The real property assessed foots up a total of \$4,078,460, being an increase over 1869 of \$67,150, a fact which must prove not a little encouraging to landed proprietors, and ought to be an inducement to those with money to invest to come and settle amongst us. In personal property there is, however, a falling off in comparison with last year, the sum total being \$886,400, against \$1,126,870 of 1869—decrease \$240,470. This is in consequence of alterations in the law regarding such property, furnishing numerous exemptions, which, under the old

law, were not allowed. It is not, therefore, that such property has decreased in value since last assessment; on the contrary, the increase in this has kept pace with the general progress. It is only that a large bulk has become unavailable by the operation of a new enactment. The assessment of incomes shows an increase of no less than \$61,100, the total for 1870 being \$169,100, as against \$108,000 of the previous year. There is a corresponding advance in the tax levied in commutation of statute labor—\$3,114, against \$2,778 of 1869; increase \$336. The total assessment for 1870 is \$5,133,960.
