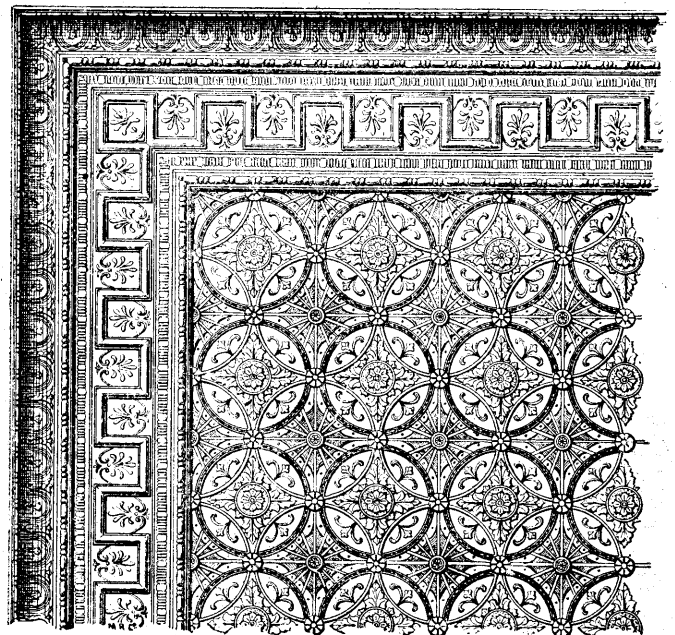


FIG. 535 - ONE OF OUR DESIGNS
